Speaking of goals, allow me to encourage some thought around the goals our students might think about as they return to school. While we are here to support student learning, it is critical the STUDENT is at the center of the work to learn. Helping each individual student recognize and achieve their potential is an important part of what we do, but students who are successful at learning (and life for that matter) have to assume the responsibility for the effort and time they put in to their learning.

What goals might this stimulate some thinking around you may ask? Attendance. The research is very clear students who are at school learn at higher levels. Make it a goal to be here at least 95% of the time.

Behavior. Students who are making the right choices to be kind, follow directions, and stay on task are more successful both academically and socially. Make it a goal to follow expectations at all times.

Families of Pleasant Valley Schools,

The winter weather has certainly wreaked havoc on the school calendar. We are considering various options, but with the potential for more weather this winter, we are waiting before making any final determinations. A few adjustments to the calendar have already been made (see below). Remember that January 26th and 27th are full days and students will be dismissed at their regular dismissal times.

The early release days are now scheduled for February 9th and 10th.

Safety

Check the weather forecast before your kids leave for school. The Pacific Northwest winters can bring some very cold days! If it's going to be extremely cold, rainy and/or high winds, make sure your kids dress warmly! Dress in layers, with a wind-resistant outer layer. Wear a hat, mittens or gloves if possible.

Attendance

Your child's attendance rate is important because students are more likely to succeed in academics when they attend school consistently. It's difficult for the teacher and the class to build their skills and progress if a large number of students are frequently absent. Your assistance in getting your child to school each and every day is greatly appreciated. We are here should you need assistance.

Important Information

Election Day is less than 25 days away. Remember to Vote on/by February 14! You will be voting on a Maintenance and Operations Levy that pays for services and materials including:

- Approximately 25% of the teacher in BGPS
- Assistant principals
- Technology in the classrooms
- Middle school counselors
- Psychologists
- Nurses and health room assistants
- Teaching assistants
- Materials for music and art classes
- Busing
- Textbooks, curricula and learning materials
