Hello,

This week begins our Lucy Calkin's Unit of Study (writing adoption) professional development series. The Units of Study are four Common Core aligned units, including one unit each in opinion, information, and narrative writing. Each unit represents six weeks of teaching, and within those six weeks, the unit supports a great many cycles of drafting and revision, as well as several

publications. Students will learn that writing with a purpose takes perseverance and grit. Students will become strategic, metacognitive writers who use specific processes to achieve particular purposes as writers.

We will also discuss chapters 2-3 from Heather Forbes' book Help for Billy. Chapter 2 suggests ways in which we can create classrooms for children that are designed to help with self-regulation. Students need us to love them unconditionally-and to nurture them, as some students have yet to the learn how to self-regulate for themselves. Chapter 3

We will learn that children are resilient and plastic, meaning a child's nervous system and neurological pathways have plasticity; the ability to change, adapt, acquire and create new and improved neurological pathways. 


